~~[C.]~~ D. Regulatory fee: In an amount established semi-annually by the commission sufficient to cover the costs of regulating professional contests, up to four percent of the total gross receipts derived by the promoter from any professional contest conducted live in New Mexico.

Supervisory fee: In an amount established semi-annually by the commission sufficient to cover the costs of supervising the exhibition of professional contests on a closed-circuit telecast, podcast or webcast or motion picture, up to five percent of the total gross receipts derived from the exhibition.
